PET POLICY

Welcome to our pet-friendly park! Please take note of the following rules and guidelines to ensure a pleasant and safe environment for all guests and their furry friends.

1. Restriction on Noisy and Aggressive Pets

Pets that exhibit excessive noise or aggression are not permitted within the park premises or the Pet Park. Specifically, Pit Bulls and Pit Bull mixes, German Shepherds, and Dobermans are prohibited breeds. Other breeds not explicitly mentioned may also be subject to restrictions. To verify if your breed is allowed, please contact us.

2. Definition of Pets and General Guidelines

Pets, which include domestic dogs, cats, and birds, are welcome in the park. However, we have a few general guidelines to ensure everyone's well-being:

- Ensure that your pet's vaccinations are up to date and have the records available upon request from the Front Desk.
- Each site is allowed a maximum of three (3) pets.
- Farm animals, such as chickens and pigs, are not considered pets and are not allowed within the park.
- Feeding of wildlife, including pigeons, birds, and feral cats, is strictly prohibited.

3. Owner's Responsibility and Pet Etiquette

As a pet owner, it is your responsibility to maintain control over your pets and prevent any incidents. Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- Pets must always be leashed or confined within the owner's RV and should never be left unattended.
- Retractable leashes are acceptable, provided they have a maximum lead length of six (6) feet.
- Dogs must be accompanied by their owners and under voice command/control while inside the park.
- Excessive barking, both inside and outside the RV, is not allowed.
- Pets are not permitted in certain areas, including the office, comfort stations, (except for service animals).
- Please prevent your dog from digging holes within the park.

4. Cleanliness and Waste Management

To keep the park clean and sanitary, please follow these waste management guidelines:

- Use the designated dog runs for your pet's waste functions, and promptly pick up and dispose of waste in the provided trash receptacles.
- This includes cleaning up pet droppings even within yourRV area.
- Avoid using grassy areas on sites, streets, or any common areas, including gravel-covered areas, as pet waste areas.
- Failure to comply with waste management rules may result in a \$25.00 fine per occurrence and potential eviction from the park for repeat offenses.

5. Laundry Facilities

Please refrain from laundering pet blankets, pillows, mats, or similar items in the park's laundry rooms.

6. Liability and Respect

The park cannot be held responsible for any injuries to pets, their owners, or other individuals using the park or Pet Park. Please show consideration for other visitors by ensuring your pet does not jump on or interfere with other people or their pets.
